



BOURBON FOR BUTTERFLIES RULES

BY PARTICIPATING, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A CONTRACT.

1. Sponsor. Friends of the Lost River (dba Lost River Cave) is the sponsor of Bourbon for Butterflies Bourbon Raffle (the "Raffle"). Lost River Cave is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The purpose of the Raffle is to raise funds for the operation of Lost River Cave's Charlie Miller Butterfly Habitat in Bowling Green, Kentucky.

2. Raffle Overview. The Raffle begins on April 13, 2026, and ends on June 1, 2026, at 10:00 am CT or when tickets are sold out, whichever occurs first.

3. Eligibility. Any person 21 years of age or older, residing where the Raffle is not prohibited, may purchase a ticket ("Ticket") to be entered in the Raffle (such person shall be herein known as the "Ticket Holder"). An affidavit of eligibility may be required from Ticket Holders who win a prize. Lost River Cave employees are prohibited from purchasing Tickets.

4. Rules. By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder accepts and agrees to be bound by all the rules, limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth herein (the "Rules"), as well as all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Lost River Cave's decisions in all matters concerning the Raffle and its interpretation and application of the Rules shall be final. Please contact Lost River Cave if you have questions regarding the Rules or the Raffle. The Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

5. Releases. By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder releases Lost River Cave, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, from any and all liability with respect to the Raffle, including, but not limited to, the selection process and the interpretation and application of the Rules, and from any and all liability for injuries, losses, or damages of any kind caused by any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize, and each Ticket Holder agrees to indemnify and hold Lost River Cave harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims, and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the winner's acceptance or use of any prize. Each Ticket Holder agrees that their name, likeness, and any statements made by them regarding the prize may be disclosed to, and used by, the news media and may otherwise be used by Lost River Cave for advertising or publicity purposes without compensation, and in lists of prize winners to be published in area newspapers and other media.

6. Tickets. The cost to purchase a Ticket for the Raffle is \$100.00 (U.S. Funds only). A maximum of 2,500 Tickets will be sold. Each Ticket has one number. Any eligible person may purchase more than one Ticket. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid Tickets sold. Tickets will not be sold after 10:00 am CT on June 1, 2026. Any unsold tickets become the property of Lost River Cave and will not be included in the drawing. The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries, or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions. A Ticket is not valid and shall not be entered in the Raffle until full and satisfactory payment for such Ticket is received by Lost River Cave. Tickets are not transferable once purchased.

7. Failure of Payment. If a Ticket Holder's payment by credit card is declined or check is dishonored by the bank for any reason, such Ticket Holder's Ticket shall be invalid and will not be entered in the drawing, unless full and satisfactory payment is made by 10:00 am CT on June 1, 2026. Lost River Cave will endeavor to notify the invalidated Ticket Holder by phone at the number provided on the ticket purchasing website; however, any failure to do so shall not cause the Ticket to become valid, cause the Ticket to be entered in the Raffle, or give rise to any claim or cause of action on behalf of the invalidated Ticket Holder.

8. Ticket Holder. Each Ticket shall be issued in a single name as provided at the time of purchase. The individual whose name appears on the Ticket shall be deemed the sole Ticket Holder and legal claimant of any prize, regardless of the identity of the purchaser. Lost River Cave shall rely solely on the name associated with the Ticket for notification and prize distribution. Lost River Cave, its directors, officers, employees, and agents shall have no liability for any disputes, errors, or misrepresentations regarding Ticket ownership or entitlement to a prize.

9. Raffle Drawing. The Raffle Drawing will take place on June 1, 2026 3:00 PM CT. In order to be eligible for the Raffle Drawing, a Ticket Holder must have purchased their Ticket online before 10:00 AM CT on June 1, 2026. Winning numbers will be randomly chosen, and the winner of the prize will be the Ticket Holder who has purchased a valid Ticket whose number matches the number chosen. All prizes will be given away. If the Raffle is not held, all money will be returned to the Ticket Holders. There is no substitution of prizes. **TICKET HOLDERS DO NOT NEED TO BE PRESENT TO WIN.**

10. Claiming a Prize. Winning Ticket Holders will be notified by phone and/or email at the number or email address provided via website when purchasing the Ticket. Lost River Cave shall notify the winner within seven days of the drawing. The winner shall claim the prize within thirty days of the drawing. Prizes can be picked up at Lost River Cave, or Lost River Cave will ship prizes to the winners, if needed, unless the winner's state laws prohibit doing so. The name of the winner will be available at Lost River Cave and online at www.lostrivercave.org/bourbon.

11. Shipping. Winners may elect to claim their prize in person at Lost River Cave, or upon request of the winner, Lost River Cave will arrange for insured shipment of prizes. All shipments must comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Shipping may not be available to winners residing in New Jersey or West Virginia due to state restrictions. Winners residing in these excluded states may be eligible to enter and win, subject to applicable law, but may need to claim their prize in person at Lost River Cave. The winner assumes all risk of loss and compliance with applicable laws upon shipment.

12. Obligations of Winning Ticket Holders. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Ticket Holder who wins the prize is responsible for all costs associated with that prize, including, but not limited to, registration, licensing, and other applicable fees, as well as all local, state, and federal taxes that may be applicable. Ticket Holders are advised to consult with a tax advisor to determine any tax liabilities.

DISCLAIMER: Must be 21 years or older to enter and must reside in the United States (excluding West Virginia and New Jersey). Grand prize drawing to be conducted live on June 1, 2026, at 3:00 PM CT. Winners will be announced at that time; there will be 4 winning tickets. An email receipt for your purchase of raffle ticket(s) will be sent following your purchase; this will include your ticket number(s). Ticket numbers will be displayed on the purchased ticket log on our website. Physical raffle tickets will not be mailed. Receipt and/or transaction numbers should not be confused with raffle ticket numbers. The winner will also be notified by phone and/or email no later than June 8, 2026.

No purchase limit applies while sufficient tickets are available; a maximum of 2,500 tickets will be sold, although the actual number sold may be significantly less. Void where participation is prohibited by law. Must be 21+ to participate. All proceeds benefit The Friends of the Lost River dba Lost River Cave, a Kentucky 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.
